



The 2008 Galston Country Music Festival

Dear Stallholder,

Enclosed please find a site application form for the 2008 Galston Country Music Festival. The Festival is a community-based event organised by the Rotary Club of Galston with the aim of raising money for a selected group of charities and to support other Rotary projects.

The event was first established in 1982 and has grown into the third largest Country Music Festival in New South Wales since the current format was developed in 1997. This year we expect another large crowd with the added attraction of our special guests. The Festival caters for all the family with plenty of kid's activities, market and food stalls, pony rides, Ute muster and bush poetry

Please note the following important information:

- Date: Sunday the 14th of September 2008 (9am to 4.30pm)
- Location: Fagan Park, Arcadia Road Galston near Hornsby in Sydney.
- Site size is approximately 4m x 3m and the cost is payable at the time of booking. • The closing date for site bookings is the 24th of August.
- The layout of the Park may be different this year and we cannot guarantee that you will be located in the same location as before.. Please indicate any preferences on the location map.
- Larger sites are available upon application to the Festival organisers.
- There will be restrictions on duplication of stalls, as we want everyone to have a profitable day. Stalls will be allocated on a first come basis, so book early.
- As this is an event organised so that charities will benefit, we know you will understand that the number of free passes is limited. Additional passes can be purchased at the time of booking for \$10 each. Family passes are also available.

A copy of the certificate of currency for your Public Liability Policy (minimum value of five million dollars) must be attached to your booking form. **NO POLICY = NO ENTRY.**

Set up is from 2pm to 4pm on Saturday or from 6.30am to 8.30am on Sunday.

Hornsby Council will not allow vehicles, including cars used to transport your stall contents, to stay at the site. All vehicles must be moved to the stallholder carpark before the Festival opens to the public.

Council will not allow vehicles back onto the park area for dismantling until after 4.00pm.

All rubbish *must be removed by the stallholder from their site* and the site must be left clean and tidy.
